God's Amazing Grace (Titus 2:11-15)

Overall theme - *Grace is the foundation, means and motivation for godly behavior.*

Grace - God's unmerited favor; God giving us something we don't deserve

What does God's grace do for us?

- I. God's grace brings salvation to man (2:11)
 - a. Jesus is the embodiment of grace
 - i. God manifests His grace in Jesus Christ - 1 John 1:17
 - b. Grace is a gift of God
 - i. It can't be earned or gained through any work of man - Ephesians 2:8-9, Romans 3:24

- II. God's grace instructs you in holy living (2:12)
 - a. Trains you to deny ungodliness and worldly desires - 1 John 2:16, Colossians 3:5
 - b. Trains you to live sensibly, righteously and godly - Ephesians 4:32

- III. God's grace points you to a future hope, the Second Coming of Christ (2:13)
 - a. When Jesus comes again, we will experience the realization of our eternal life - glorified body, eternity with God - Philippians 3:21, 1 Corinthians 15:42-44, 51-53, 1 John 3:3

- IV. God's grace enables us to live godly lives (2:14)
 - a. You are redeemed - bought out of the bondage of sin - Ephesians 1:7, Colossians 1:14, 1 Peter 1:18-19, Romans 3:24-26
 - b. You are purified - forgiven of your sins - 1 John 1:9, Ephesians 1:3

- V. God's grace motivates you to do good works (2:15)
 - a. We are God's workmanship - Ephesians 2:10
 - b. Give yourself fully to the work of God—1 Corinthians 15:58

Amazing Grace

- God's saving grace gives salvation
- God's sanctifying grace instructs in godly living
- God's eternal grace gives us hope for the Second Coming of Jesus
- God's sustaining grace gives us power to live as a new creation and be zealous for good works
