### **Psalm 116:1-19 (NLT)**

- <sup>1</sup> I love the LORD because he hears my voice and my prayer for mercy.**
- <sup>2</sup> Because he bends down to listen, I will pray as long as I have breath!**
- <sup>3</sup> Death wrapped its ropes around me; the terrors of the grave overtook me. I saw only trouble and sorrow.**
- <sup>4</sup> Then I called on the name of the LORD: "Please, LORD, save me!"**
- <sup>5</sup> How kind the LORD is! How good he is! So merciful, this God of ours!**
- <sup>6</sup> The LORD protects those of childlike faith; I was facing death, and he saved me.**

- <sup>11</sup> In my anxiety I cried out to you, "These people are all liars!"**
- <sup>12</sup> What can I offer the LORD for all he has done for me?**
- <sup>13</sup> I will lift up the cup of salvation and praise the LORD's name for saving me.**
- <sup>14</sup> I will keep my promises to the LORD in the presence of all his people.**
- <sup>15</sup> The LORD cares deeply when his loved ones die.**
- <sup>16</sup> O LORD, I am your servant; yes, I am your servant, born into your household; you have freed me from my chains.**
- <sup>17</sup> I will offer you a sacrifice of thanksgiving and call on the name of the LORD.**
- <sup>18</sup> I will fulfill my vows to the LORD in the presence of all his people—**
- <sup>19</sup> in the house of the LORD in the heart of Jerusalem. Praise the LORD!**
