Webster's 1828: "Fidelity; loyalty; firm adherence to allegiance and duty."

God's Faithfulness

We depend upon God's faithfulness for:

-Our final salvation. 1 Corinthians 1:8-9: "*He will keep you strong to the end so that you will be free from all blame on the day when our Lord Jesus Christ returns. 9 God will do this, for he is faithful to do what he says, and he has invited you into partnership with his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.*"

-Deliverance from temptation. 1 Corinthians 10:13: "*The temptations in your life are no different from what others experience. And God is faithful. He will not allow the temptation to be more than you can stand. When you are tempted, he will show you a way out so that you can endure.*"

-Ultimate sanctification. 1 Thessalonians 5:23: "*Now may the God of peace make you holy in every way, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless until our Lord Jesus Christ comes again.*"

-Forgiveness of our sins. 1 John 1:9: "*But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.*"

-Deliverance through times of suffering. 1 Peter 4:19: "*So if you are suffering in a manner that pleases God, keep on doing what is right, and trust your lives to the God who created you, for he will never fail you.*" [notice it doesn't say from, but through].

-The fulfillment of our ultimate hope of eternal life. Hebrews 10:23: "*Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep his promise.*"

Psalm 145:13: "*For your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom. You rule throughout all generations. The Lord always keeps his promises; he is gracious in all he does.*"

Our Faithfulness-correct, true, authentic, honest, genuine, integrity

Luke 16:10-"If you are faithful in little things, you will be faithful in large ones. But if you are dishonest in little things, you won't be honest with greater responsibilities."
