First Supper | Pastor Scott Mark 14:12-26

The Passover Meal:

+Lamb: Passover Sacrifice

+Unleavened Bread: Rapid exodus;

+Saltwater: tears of bondage +bitter herbs: slavery to Egypt +Several rounds of wine;

Exodus 6:6-7; ""Therefore, say to the people of Israel: 'I am the Lord. I will free you from your oppression and will rescue you from your slavery in Egypt. I will redeem you with a powerful arm and great acts of judgment. ⁷ I will claim you as my own people, and I will be your God. Then you will know that I am the Lord your God who has freed you

from your oppression in Egypt."

1. Rescue from Egypt

- 2. Freedom from slavery
- 3. Redemption by God's Power (Thanksgiving; this was the one shared)
- 4. Renewed relationship with God (This was the one Jesus abstained from)

Preparation of Last Supper (14:12-17)

Dinner Surprise! (14:18-21)
