Self-Study Guide: Trinity – Father and What Else

1. Personal Reflection

- Reflect on your own comfort zones in studying complex or controversial topics in scripture. Why do you think some aspects of God's identity are challenging or avoided?

2. Exploring God as Father

- Consider the analogy of a father's role and how it relates to God's relationship with humanity.
- Reflect on the significance of calling God "Father" and what it means to be an heir to The Elohim, the giver of life.
- **Key Passage:** Galatians 4:6-7. Meditate on what it means to cry out "Abba, Father" and the deeper implications of being heirs with the Creator.

3. God's Creative Purpose

- Examine the idea that God created humanity to manage and govern creation, not out of loneliness but out of joy and purpose. Reflect on the design of being "in His likeness" and the limitations and opportunities this brings.

4. Imagery of Covenant and Marriage

- Study the recurring imagery of God as Husband to His people, as depicted in both Old and New Testament passages. Explore the covenant relationship and its parallels to marriage.
- **Key Passages:** Genesis 17:7, Exodus 6:7, Ezekiel 34:24, Jeremiah 31:33, Revelation 21:1-4, Isaiah 54:5-8, Hosea 2:19-23, Ephesians 5:22-33.

5. Jesus as Groom/Husband

- Reflect on the transition from God as Husband in the Old Testament to Jesus as Groom in the New Testament. Consider the theological implications of Jesus being both God and man, and how this affects your understanding of the Trinity.

6. Practical Application: Living as the Bride of Christ

- Contemplate what it means to act as the bride of Christ, regardless of gender. How does this imagery challenge traditional roles and encourage deeper love and unity within the Church?
- **Key Passage:** Ephesians 5. Reflect on the call to love as Christ loves the Church, and how this shapes relationships and spiritual identity. *Be careful to not use this as a weapon on others, but always as a way to help build up others.

7. Prayer and Worship

- Study Jesus' instruction to pray to the Father (Matthew 6:9) and the significance of God's affirmation of Jesus as Son. Reflect on the unity of the Trinity and the invitation to enter into relationship with Yahweh.

8. Summary & Personal Commitment

- Summarize your insights from each section. Write a personal reflection or prayer expressing your understanding of God as Father, Husband, and Creator.
- Consider practical steps to prepare yourself as the bride of Christ, living in unity and love with God and others.

- Look up and meditate on the referenced scriptures.
- Discuss your insights with a study group or mentor if possible.
- Revisit challenging concepts and pray for deeper understanding.
