Message - Jesus The Bread Of Life

Sermon Big Picture - Having fed the crowds, Jesus gained a huge following, but not for the right reason. Here Jesus will expose their real motivation, and the truth of who He is.

Scripture: John 6:40-59

Examination

1. How does V.40 give assurance to those who believe one Jesus?
2. What does it mean to "look on Jesus and believe"?
3. When Jesus doesn't give people what they want, but instead turns the focus too Himself, the people grumble and try to deny His claims. How does this still occur today?
4. In V. 44, we see a profound statement about God's work in our salvation. What does this passage say is required for a person to come to Jesus?
5. In V. 44, the one who is drawn by the Father "will" be raised up. How does this reveal that the one who us "drawn" by the Father will believe and be saved?
6. In V. 47-58, Jesus reveals Himself to be the bread of life. How does He point back to God providing manna for Israel in the wilderness? Through this, who does He make Himself out to be?

Application

1. How does this passage warn us to examine our own motives for following Jesus?
2. Using the analogy of eating and drinking, how does Jesus intend us to understand who He is and what He does for us?

Personal Discipline

Who do You believe Jesus is? What is it that you are looking to Jesus for? Examine your heart, and look to Jesus as He has revealed Himself to be. Receive from Him what He has promised. He has far bigger things He desires to do for us than we have or ourselves.
