Scripture: Revelations 2:1-7

Welcome & Connection

Do you remember a time when you really fell in love with Jesus (or when was a time when you felt really close to God)? What were you doing during this time that showed your love for Jesus?

Connect Group Questions

1. Ephesus worshipped the gods of sex and politics. How do you see our culture, and even Christians in the church, being saturated by and giving allegiance to sex and politics? What are the effects of worshipping these things?
2. The church in Ephesus was doing many things right—they were working hard, enduring, rejecting false teaching, and standing firm. Yet Jesus said they had abandoned their first love. How can we be doing the right things for Jesus while slowly losing our love for Jesus?
3. Jesus gives the Ephesians three instructions: remember, repent, and redo. Which of these three do you think is most important for someone whose relationship with Jesus has grown cold? Why?
4. What are some things that can slowly replace our love and intimacy with Jesus—without us even realizing it? Have you ever experienced a season where following Jesus became more about checking boxes than genuinely knowing Him?
5. Jesus tells the Ephesians to return to the things they did at first. What is one practical thing you could begin doing again this week that would help you reconnect with Jesus and rekindle your love for Him?
