Kingdom Here, Kingdom There Week 2

### **Welcome & Connection**

- Have you ever run a race of any kind? What encourages you to keep going, whether in a race or any other area of life?

### **Connect Group Questions**

1. What is currently ruling your life?

The sermon emphasized that everyone serves a kingdom. What area of your life is most difficult to fully surrender to the kingship of Jesus, and why?

Key Verse: Matthew 4:17

2. Have you settled for "sitting at the gate?"

Like the lame man in Acts 3, many people stay close to God but never fully experience the freedom and restoration He offers. Is there an area where you've become comfortable living with less than what God desires for you?

Follow-up: What would it look like to trust Jesus with that area?

3. How has Jesus restored something that sin, pain, or brokenness once damaged in your life?

Share a personal testimony of God's work in your life. How can your story encourage someone else who may be struggling today?

Key Thought: The Kingdom is not just something we believe; it's something we experience.

4. What does it practically mean to be an “ambassador” of Christ in your everyday life?

Think about your home, workplace, school, team, or community. Where has God placed you to represent His Kingdom, and what would it look like to intentionally live as His ambassador there this week?

Key Verse: 2 Corinthians 5:20

5. If every believer in our church lived out this message for the next 30 days, what impact would it have?

What would change in our communities, our schools, workplaces, neighborhoods, and families if we truly carried the Kingdom “there” after experiencing it “here”?

Challenge Question: What’s one specific action you can take this week to bring the hope, love, or truth of Jesus to someone else?

Before ending, have each person answer:

“This week, one place I need to carry the Kingdom is \_\_\_\_\_.”
