- Learning to love others – through this freedom



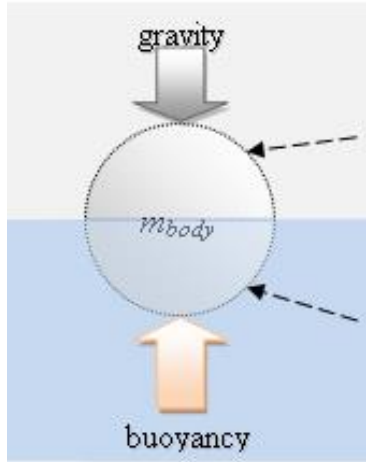

$$F_B = \rho_f V_f g$$

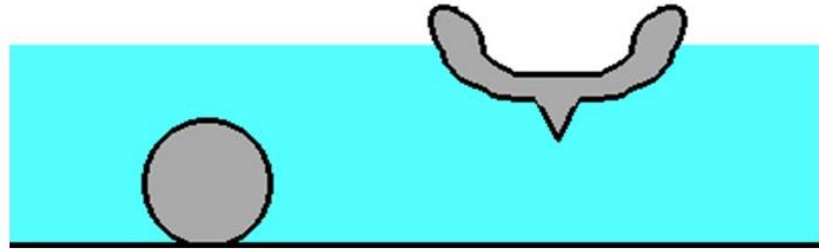


$V$  = Volume of

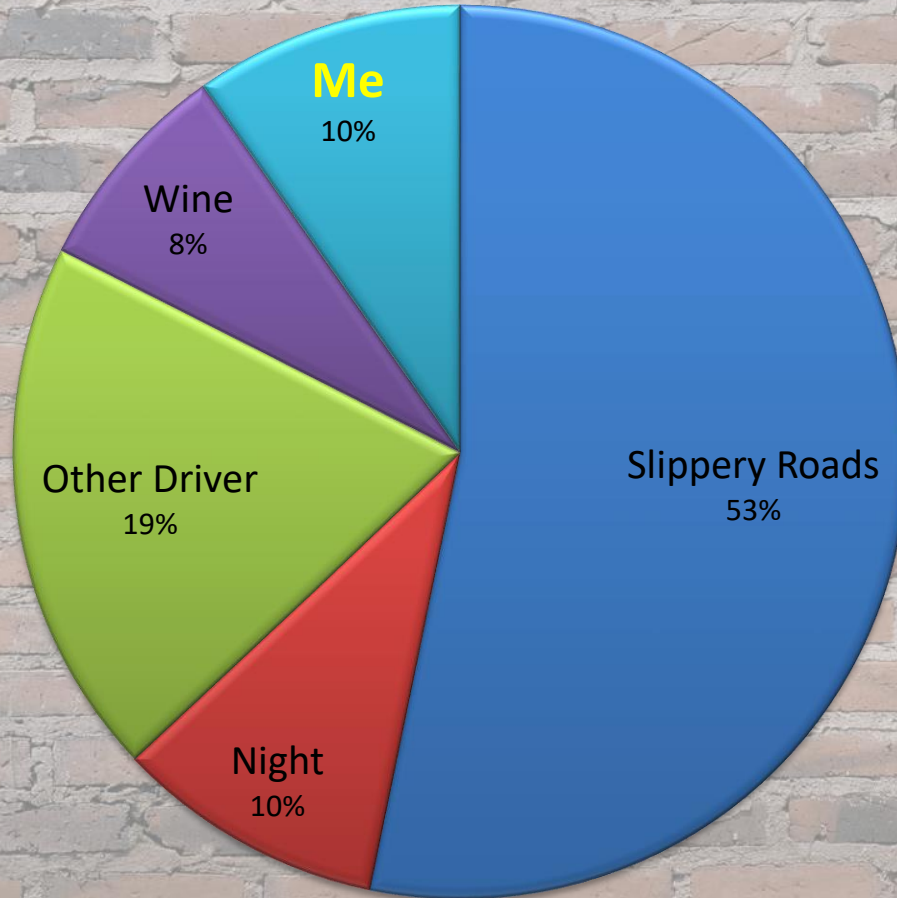


# Later and Greater
