¹⁸ On that day the LORD made a covenant with Abram...





 - In your seed all nations will be blessed

NIV Galatians 3:16 The promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. The Scripture does not say "and to seeds," meaning many people, but "and to your seed," meaning one person, who is Christ.

NAU Galatians 3:19a, 22-24


¹⁹ Why the Law then? It was added because of transgressions...

²³ But before faith came, we were kept in custody under the law, being shut up to the faith which was later to be revealed.
²⁴ Therefore the Law has become our tutor to lead us to Christ, so that we may be justified by faith.

The Law:

Kept the behaviour within boundaries
 The discipline of a strict teacher
 Led the people to Christ





Galatians 3:21b if a law had been given which was able to impart life, then righteousness would indeed have been based on law.

NIV James 2:10 For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles at just one point is guilty of breaking all of it.

Galatians 3

²¹ Is the Law then contrary to the promises of God? May it never be!
For if a law had been given which was able to impart life, then righteousness would indeed have been based on law.
¹⁷ What I am saying is this: the Law, which came four hundred and thirty years later, does not invalidate a covenant previously ratified by God, so as to nullify the promise.

²² But the Scripture has shut up everyone under sin, so that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe.
²⁵ But now that faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor.
²⁹ And if you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's descendants, heirs according to promise.

NET Galatians 5:1For freedom Christ has set us free.Stand firm, then, and do not be subject again to the yoke of slavery.

God-Human Relationship

NAU Galatians 4:1

¹ Now I say, as long as the heir is a child, he does not differ at all from a slave although he is owner of everything, but he is under guardians and managers until the date set by the father.

³ So also we, while we were children, were held in bondage under the elemental things of the world.

⁴ But when the fullness of the time came, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law, so that He might redeem those who were under the Law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.

⁶ Because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"

⁷ Therefore you are no longer a slave, but a son; and if a son, then an heir through God.


God-Human Relationship

Living out the gospel of Christ





- 1. Surrender in faith to Jesus
- 2. Confess
