<u>Children's Church Updates (Grade K-5)</u> This month, we are discussing thankfulness.

The Bible talks about "thanksgiving" 115 times! Maybe God gave us lots of reminders about Thankfulness because He knows how easily we can take things for granted. I believe there's other reasons that "giving thanks" is so common in scripture: the Author of Life knows gratitude is good for us. Like all His teachings, giving thanks leads to a fuller, happier life for us and those around us.

This month, we will investigate stories in the Bible how men and women of God gave thanks, sang praises, and honored God through worship. We will see how the heart of God longs for us to fellowship and commune with Him. May our kids will hold tight to God's word and grow in their love and faith in God.

The children are taught Bible truths through puppet skits, interactive Bible studies, object lessons, crafts, and much more. Sarah Joannou and Connie Warren are leading the classes.
