Imagine having a bodyguard with you 24 hours a day. One that is all knowing, all powerful, can see the past, present, and future. He never sleeps or takes a break. You might be thinking that is impossible. Well, what if I told you not only is it possible but it's free for you! That's what God is for us. He's our bodyguard, and He paid the price for it, not us. Where can I find help?

The Women's Ministry has not only been learning how to "worry less" but we have also been learning how to spend more time with God. Youth updates

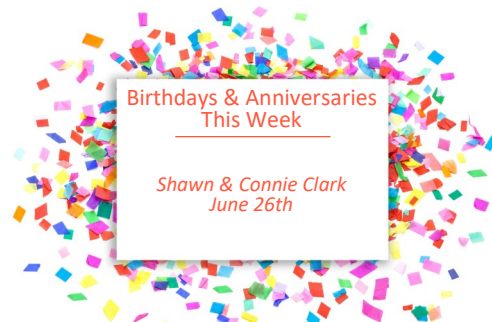
