




1. Angels are created beings.



(Matthew 22:29-30)





full of his glory!" (Isaiah 6:1-3)**



“Are they not all ministering spirits sent out to serve for the sake of those who are to inherit salvation?” (Hebrews 1:14)








Angels and Jesus' birth/life...

- **Messengers – predicted Jesus coming and announced His birth.**



“And there appeared to him an angel of the Lord standing on the right side of the altar of incense. And Zechariah was troubled when he saw him, and fear fell upon him. But the angel said to him, "Do not be afraid, Zechariah, for your prayer has been heard, and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John.” (Luke 1:11-13)




“In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. And the virgin's name was Mary. ... And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus. (Luke 1:26-27, 31)

(Matthew 2:13)


