- 22 stanzas based on the Hebrew alphabet
- 8 lines in each stanza
- Each line begins with the same letter within a stanza
- 8 different words to describe Scripture

- 1 All those whose way is blameless are blessed,
who walk in the law of lord!
- 2 Approved are those who keep his testimonies,
who seek him with their whole heart;
- 3 Anyone who does no wrong,
but walks in his ways,
- 4 And you command your precepts
to be kept carefully.
- 5 Ah, that my ways may be steadfast
in keeping your statutes!
- 6 Among my detractors I will stand,
having my eyes fixed on all your commandments.
- 7 Acclaiming you with an upright heart,
I learn your righteous ordinances.
- 8 As I keep your statutes,
do not utterly forsake me.

- 9 By what means can a young man keep his way pure?
By guarding it according to your word.
- 10 Being wholehearted in my seeking,
I still need your help to stick to your commandments!
- 11 Building a store of your word in my heart
helps ensure that I do not sin against you.
