



Is Everything You Do Unto The Lord? (Pt.4)

Colossians 1, Matthew 5:6 AMP

- You cannot pray for discipline; discipline is a ***choice***
- God gave us this ability in the beginning of humankind (Gen 1:26-28).
- If you don't exercise what you have, it will become dormant (*inactive, inoperative*)



Is Everything You Do Unto The Lord? (Pt.4)

Colossians 1, Matthew 5:6 AMP

- The Lord's Prayer is a command, not a soft prayer.
- God has given us the power to declare and decree as a born again believer.
- Prayer doesn't always take crying, weeping, and being broken before the Lord, it takes speaking **boldly** and with **authority** the word of the Lord.



Is Everything You Do Unto The Lord? (Pt.4)

Colossians 1, Matthew 5:6 AMP

- There are favors waiting for ***you!***
- Why are you begging for a favor that's right there for you?
- Salvation (Grk. ***Sōtēria***)- *rescue, deliverance, safe from danger*



Is Everything You Do Unto The Lord? (Pt.4)

Colossians 1, Matthew 5:6 AMP

- Righteousness (Grk. *euthutēs*)— uprightness, a straight (not crooked) object.
- Selfishness leads to lack of harmony; your foot can't decide to leave the body and still work.
- It also leads to grumpy attitudes.



Is Everything You Do Unto The Lord? (Pt.4)

Colossians 1, Matthew 5:6 AMP

- Self-righteousness is only caring about your morals.
- The word says to care for the righteousness of the earth (right standing morals)



Is Everything You Do Unto The Lord? (Pt.4)

Colossians 1, Matthew 5:6 AMP

- Hunger creates a desire or craving for something.
- Hunger is something ***you*** create.
- Do you have a hunger for the Lord?



Is Everything You Do Unto The Lord? (Pt.4)

Colossians 1, Matthew 5:6 AMP

- People want the healing of the Lord without changing themselves or their lifestyle.
- *How can you ask for God to heal your lungs if you keep smoking?*
- Having a hunger makes you identify the problems.
