



Be Careful How You Hear

Luke 8:18 AMP, 2 Timothy 3:16 KJV

- If you don't know how you got in a place that God mercifully pulled you out of, there's a high chance you'll do it again.
- Read Luke 8 to understand the context of verse 18.
- Perfect Scripture = perfect constitution



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- God gives us the Word even though we're imperfect.
- We can be in relationship with Christ, but our actions may not follow Him as it should.
- Why would a perfect God take away from an ***imperfect*** person? Because it's a mandate for us to be hearers of the Word.



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- People think they know the Word based on what was said versus what is written; This applies to the constitution and American laws as well.
- Often people add their own interpretation of what is written which leads to deception, confusion and ignorance.



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- **2 Timothy 3:16**; The Word is given by God for clarity, instruction, righteousness, etc, but if you don't know it, you won't make it far.
- God can use anyone no matter how messed up they are.
- We look at a believer's flaws as a human but disregard their work for the Lord (David, Peter, Abraham, etc)



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- Everything we have in this nation is because of the Bible.
- Why highlight only the bad and imperfections of this nation when there's so much good that outweighs it?
- Unless you're going to change the problem, drop it.
