(Psalms 34:19 AMP, TPT)



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- God's love for you doesn't exempt you from hardship.
 - All that we do that is good isn't unto people, it's unto God.
 - Don't assume that the good you're sowing into is always where you'll receive the good back.



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- Some people that sow into something (like a church) do so for attention or recognition.
 - There's people that drive others from you, but that same person stays around you, that's evil.
 - If you're truly turning something over to the Lord, stop being involved or taking control.



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- You need to learn to let go, it'll cause more problems for you.
 - You need to discern if it's the devil at play through the person you're dealing with (ex. The story of Job).
 - He suffered and didn't get back what he lost; it wasn't about the stuff, it was about God.

- David did nothing; He didn't retaliate.

- Don't chase people that don't want to be caught.
