



Are You Stuck?

James 1:19-27, Hebrews 4:1-16,
Psalm 127:1-2 (AMP/TPT)

- All of us are on a journey where we have to understand the purpose of it.
- We tend to measure ourselves by what we believe vs. measuring ourselves based on the Word.
- We're stuck by the language that comes out of our mouth; you're defeated by your own negative talk.



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- Engrafted (grk. Émphytos) – planted, inborn, or rooted (*James 1:21*)
- How do you act when someone pushes against your theory of what you believe?
- Challenge what they say.



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- When you're engrafted, you're sewn into the one body of Christ.
- When you're rooted in the Word, your old language won't match the words of God.
- Life and death is in the power of the tongue; watch your words.



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- We're defiled by how we speak, not what goes in us.
- You can't say "you know God will..." then say "I'm not going to make it", that's contradicting.
- Don't put death to your life based on the outward appearance of the situation.
- The promise is in your mouth and is magnified when we come together as believers.



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- You can't allow certain things to fulfill your appetite when you're going through a tough time.
- You can't allow the enemy to deter you from Christ.
- Grow in grace when you're engrafted.
- Without faith, it's impossible to please God (Heb 11:6).
- Faith makes you confident that you will pass the hardship in your life.



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- Hebrews 4:7 – start walking in your Today and get out of being stuck.
