- The way you respond to life is not set on what you see in the earth, it's how you view the heavens.
- Why do you listen to people on earth instead of God?

- Your life is now in Christ, not in the customs of the world.
- Why go back to the hell you came from?

- Separate, kill and deprive yourself from sinful nature.
- You've been living in idolatry and need to separate yourself from loving you.
- Deifying – worship, regard, or treat someone or something as a god.

- God gets angry at his own children for being disobedient, just as a parent deals with their child when they are disobedient.
- God may have a calling and will for you, but when you choose to ignore Him, He'll deal with you in ways that may hurt.

- If you want to be more like God, try being more tenderhearted.
- If you see someone heading the wrong way, why not try to direct them on the right path, despite what you think they'll think of you?
