



The Table Of The Lord

Gen 14:17-23, Matthew 26:26-29 (KJV/NLT)

- Eucharis, Lord's supper, Table of the Lord; the name doesn't matter, it all means the same thing.
- Salem (*shalom* – *peace*) – the original name of Jerusalem.
- Melchizedek – king of righteousness.
- Christophany – the preincarnate appearance or manifestation of Jesus Christ.



The Table Of The Lord

Gen 14:17-23, Matthew 26:26-29 (KJV/NLT)

- Melchizedek held more than one position; a king and a priest.
- The first time we see the word **priest** is in Genesis.
- 400+ years before the law was ever instituted.
- Words will eventually evolve, but if you know the origin (archetype), you'll know the original meaning.

The Table Of The Lord

Gen 14:17-23, Matthew 26:26-29 (KJV/NLT)



Verse 21

- There were two kings; Melchizedek who offered bread and wine, and the King of Sodom who offered him to keep his earnings.
- Abram decided to give a tenth of his earnings out of the abundance of his heart, not for the king of Sodom to say he made him rich.



The Table Of The Lord

Gen 14:17-23, Matthew 26:26-29 (KJV/NLT)

- Melchizedek was ***before*** the law; Abram wasn't obligated to give first, the priest gave first and ***then*** Abram gave his tenth.
- When you're in the presence of the Lord, must take all of Him, not some of Him.
- **Matt. 26:26-29**) Jesus made a new will (testament) to leave the Levitical order (the law) and go back to Melchiz.'s way.
