Message Notes

Core Truth

- God doesn't waste pain — He uses it to position us for redemption.

1. Survival Season (Ruth 1–2)

- Ruth and Naomi return empty and grieving
- Ruth gleans in the fields just to survive
- Even in survival mode, God is working behind the scenes

2. Unexpected Favor (Ruth 2)

- Boaz notices Ruth and shows kindness
- Favor comes before she earns anything
- God's favor is based on His character, not performance

3. Position of Trust (Ruth 3)

- Ruth moves from working to trusting
- Surrender leads to breakthrough
- Faith shifts from striving to resting in God

4. The Redeemer Moves (Ruth 4)

- Boaz redeems Ruth publicly
- Identity shifts: Outsider to Family, Survivor to Secure
- Redemption changes who you are, not just your situation

5. Legacy Is Born

- Ruth becomes part of the lineage of David and Jesus
- Your yes today can impact generations tomorrow

Final Reflection

- Where am I right now — Surviving, Waiting, Trusting, or Restored?

- No matter the season, the response is: Yes, Lord

Still Yes Declarations

- To God: I trust Your will, timing, and surrender my future
- To My Spouse: I choose you again and commit to our covenant

- Redemption gave her a future
