Psalm 44:9 But you have rejected and disgraced us. . . ¹¹ You have made us like sheep for slaughter. . . ¹⁷ All this has come upon us, though we have not forgotten you, ¹⁸ Our heart has not turned back, ¹⁹ yet you have broken us in the place of jackals. . . ²³ Awake! Why are you sleeping, O Lord? Rouse yourself! Do not reject us forever! ²⁴ Why do you hide your face? Why do you forget our affliction and oppression?
