

All nations would believe and gather at Mount Zion to feast with the Lord (Isa 25:6-8, 56:1-8, 66:18-20; Zech 14:16-19; cf Isa 2:2-4). As the Feast of Ingathering (Tabernacles) was the completion of the annual cycle of religious pilgrimages (Ex 23:14-17), so also the ingathering of the Gentiles was to be the ultimate culmination of the story of God's people.

That means the day has begun when even Gentiles who trust Messiah can be justified by God's grace AND sanctified.

²⁴ Truly I tell you, unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains by itself. But if it dies, it produces much fruit. [This is what Jesus does. Instead of remaining singular, He gives His life so that many may gain <u>salvation</u> in Him.]

²⁵ The one who loves his life will lose it, and the one who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. [This is justification. One surrenders one's own way to believe in Jesus alone and is thus made eternally alive.]


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If anyone serves me, the Father will honor him. [This is glorification. The Father will honor and Jesus will reward those who serve Him.]

²⁷ "Now my soul is troubled. What should I say—Father, save me from this hour? But that is why I came to this hour. ²⁸ Father, glorify your name."

Then a voice came from heaven: "I have glorified it, and I will glorify it again."

²⁹The crowd standing there heard it and said it was thunder. Others said, "An angel has spoken to him."

The Yanomamis do not use metaphors like other languages, employing similes (like or as) instead. They also do not naturally use "light" symbolically, so the translation is meaningless without some explanation of how Jesus is light. So we put it like this: "I am like a thing that causes light for all people. If someone follows me, he won't be like one who goes on a dark trail. Inside him will be a thing that gives light to his mind."



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³⁷ Even though he had performed so many signs in their presence, they did not believe in him. 38 This was to fulfill the word of Isaiah the prophet, who said: Lord, who has believed our message? And to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed? [Isaiah 53] ³⁹ This is why they were unable to believe, because Isaiah also said: ⁴⁰ He has blinded their eyes and hardened their hearts, so that they would not see with their eyes or understand with their hearts, and turn, and I would heal them. 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


Too often, Christians choose the affirming people option...
