The most frequent noun for "love" in the Old Testament, דְּקֶּבָּד (chesed), occurs over 250 times in the Hebrew Bible. The term does not have a clear equivalent translation. The KJV translates it as "lovingkindness," while newer translations use "steadfast love" (ESV) or "loyal love" (LEB). Some translators use "mercy," following the Septuagint translation (ἔλεος, eleos). In context, "loyal love" (τοπ, chesed) refers to two people or groups of people who have previously formed a relationship.






<sup>3</sup> Blessed is the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavens in Christ.

The fact is that this grace is above all measure. Yet we have four measures for it-height, depth, breadth, length-and this mercy of God is so exceeding great that in each of these measures it baffles description. It is higher than our sin, though that be exceedingly heinous and proudly threatens the gates of heaven; it is higher than our thoughts, though our imagination sometimes takes a condor's flight. Oh, the height of divine mercy! It rises to the throne of the Eternal. As for the depths of grace, -the sea has immense depths, but the mercy of God is altogether unfathomable. Great sins sink into it and are lost; but grace is just as deep after it has swallowed up a worlds' sin as it was before.


There are inconceivably deep places in God's mercy where the blackest sins are lost. Out of these come the choicest pearls of grace. Oh the depths! As for the breadth of mercy, David says, "As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us." What greater breadth can be conceived? As for the length of it, it is from everlasting to everlasting. Can anybody tell me the length of that? My sins began less than fifty years ago; but the Lord's mercy began- ah, when did it begin? 






I AM's benevolences will pursue me (yirdepûnî, cf. Hos. 2:7 [9]) as in a chase or hunt so as not to allow the beneficiary to escape I AM's unfailing desire and commitment to do him good. What a contrast is the pagan's conceptions of God with the Biblical. Many pagans imagine their gods as demonic, and/or hideous to look at—sometimes dragon-like in form—and demanding apotropaic sacrifices—even child sacrifice—to ward off their hostility. Instead of demanding human sacrifice the God of Israel sacrificed his own Son to satisfy his justice. No religion rivals God's revelation of himself as a God of sacrificial love.

David realized that the Lord's good loyal love (hesed) would go with him everywhere through all his life. God's blessings on His people remain with them no matter what their circumstance may be. (Cf. God's goodness in 27:13; 31:19; 69:16; 86:17; 109:21; 116:12; 142:7; 145:7.)







It is worth reiterating at his point that sheep can, under mismanagement, be the most destructive livestock. In short order they can ruin and ravage land almost beyond remedy. But in bold contrast they can, on the other hand, be the most beneficial of all livestock if properly managed.

Their manure is the best balanced of any produced by domestic stock. When scattered efficiently over the pastures it proves of enormous benefit to the soil. The sheep's habit of seeking the highest rise of ground on which to rest insures that the fertility from the rich lowland is redeposited on the less productive higher ground. No other livestock will consume as wide a variety of herbage. Sheep eat all sorts of weeds and other undesirable plants that might otherwise invade a field. For example, they love the buds and tender tips of Canada thistle, which, if not controlled, can quickly become a most noxious weed. In a few years a flock of wellmanaged sheep will clean up and restore a piece of ravaged land as no other creature can do.




## A psalm of thanksgiving.

- <sup>5</sup> For the LORD is good, and his faithful love endures forever; his faithfulness, through all generations.


