Persico shows *In God's Image* that it is not science and technical progress that nurtures modern atheism but rather the very “image of God” tradition revolting against God. Atheism is thus a normative rather than a scientific position: An all-powerful God eventually becomes the obstacle to individual “flourishing.” Supposed human value comes from denying God’s very existence. Mr. Persico might have added the well-known words of the anarchist Mikhail Bakunin: “If God really existed, it would be necessary to abolish him.” – Ana Siljak, “The Idea that Changed the World”

Rubin's reasoning is fatally conflicted because he is trying to uphold two incompatible moral instincts at once:

- 1. The intuitive belief that human life has inherent value.**
- 2. The secular ethic that value is assigned by desire, convenience, and autonomy.**

This is yet another moment when Christianity proves itself a far sturdier platform upon which to stand. The Christian worldview holds that human beings possess dignity not because of their capabilities, but because we bear the image of our Creator (Genesis 1:27). Your worth is not measured by usefulness, independence, or potential. It is bestowed, not earned.
