

LUST/DESIRES

These desires are characterized by their overwhelming and unsatisfying nature and their potential to dominate a person's thoughts and actions, sometimes leading to behavior that prioritizes the fulfillment of these desires over moral or ethical considerations. These desires are intense, excessive and overpowering. They are not from God.









WHAT IS THE LUST OF THE EYES?


The lust of the eyes is a mental pleasure that is stimulated by what we see.

1 CORINTHIANS 7:31


For the world in its current fashion is passing away.
