- Does the thought/activity/choice draw me closer into healthy Christian community?



Phil must be separated from God's love because he is acting like a fool.






from you (at least temporarily) through their death or yours. But God's Word promises that even in death there is no separation from God's love – ever (see 2 Corinthians 5:8).

We need to cultivate in our own hearts the same hatred of sin God has. Hatred of sin as sin, not just as something disquieting or defeating to ourselves, but as displeasing to God, lies at the root of all true holiness...We need to brace ourselves up and to realize that we are responsible for thoughts, attitudes, and actions. We need to reckon on the fact that we died to sin's reign, that it no longer has any dominion over us, that God has united us with the risen Christ in all His power


