Paul dashes any silly notion of independent victory when he describes the character of our greatest enemies. They are not 'flesh and blood,' but a host of evil spirits directed by the devil himself and sent out to war against the saints...whether you like it or not, you must go into the ring against Satan. He has not only general malice against the army of saints, but a particular spite against every single child of God."



- Tempt Christians to lies, immorality, self-righteousness and other sins.

#### My Dear Wormwood,

Be sure that the patient remains completely fixated on politics. Arguments, political gossip, and obsessing on the faults of people they have never met serves as an excellent distraction from advancing in personal virtue [and] character...Make sure to keep the patient in a constant state of angst, frustration and general disdain towards the rest of the human race in order to avoid any kind of charity or inner peace from further developing. 

### Why does Satan so hate us?

It all comes down to what Satan knows is planned – Jesus will be triumphant, and God the Father will be praised. Christians play a role in each of those, and it galls the enemy.

- Satan [using demons and humans] battles Jesus in establishing His church as a spiritual kingdom.
- Satan [using demons and earthly leaders] will try to stop Jesus' millennial physical kingdom.

Thus, until that physical kingdom is established:

- Christians will be in spiritual war.
- Israel will be a physical flashpoint.

[This is] a war between the Saint and Satan. And it is such a bloody one that the cruelest war ever fought by men will be seen as but sport and child's play compared to this. [Note – he wrote this after seeing the English Civil War and the wicked persecutions levied against the Puritans.] It is a spiritual war...a war now going on – the tragedy is present with us. And it is not taking place at the farthest end of the world; it concerns you



and everyone who reads of it.


# Stages of Wound Healing

more than 500!" (I Corinthians 15:2-6) - Dan Bolin





By context, praying in the Spirit means: praying scripture (6:17), yielded to God (5:18), in unity with all brethren (4:3-4, 2:22, 2:18), strengthened internally by God (3:16), rejoicing in God's plan (3:5), knowing you are secure (1:13-14).


