These become an important basis for a sanctuary revealed later in scripture: God dwelling in people who trust Messiah.





Psalm 68 was sung during the Israelite celebration known as Pentecost. Pentecost was a feast celebrating the wheat harvest that was held 50 days after the Passover & Firstfruits feasts.



By New Testament times, the rabbis held that Pentecost was also a celebration of Moses coming down Sinai; because, they said, Moses came down with the Law on the 50<sup>th</sup> day after they left Egypt.








**Ephesians 4 CSB** 

"Descended" describes how Jesus gave Himself to even sinful humanity on earth. He gave the Holy Spirit to permanently indwell those who receive Him as Savior. Descended is designed to show how Jesus is even greater than Moses who was merely human. Jesus came as God Himself, deigning to come down.

Greek: πληρόω pleroo = fullness; brightness

Herodotus used pleroo to describe a full moon, emphasizing that the moon reflects the power of the sun.






