





The waves wind down while the drowning person is rescued. Then, the turbines have to cool for 5 minutes before the waves can restart.

























Pelagius ca. A.D. 354-418

- Grace [unearned favor from God] is nice but not necessary


Ruins of the basilica where the council met in 431

- Grace is both lovely and absolutely necessary



In Greek thought, to be a "prince" was to have great authority. To be over the air was to be over all of life.
