
Burial of Jesus Vilmos Zsolnay 1895

## The logic [of the term goes] like this:

- (1) Jesus claimed to be God's Son in a special sense. He argued that God was his Father (John 5:18)...He claimed that whoever had seen him had seen the Father (John 14:9). Those statements were all claims to divinity, and because of them the religious leaders killed him.
- (2) Those claims are either true or false.
- (3) If those claims are false, they are deceitful and blasphemous.
- (4) If they are blasphemous, it is inconceivable that God the Father could eternally honor the one who made them.
- (5) But God did honor Jesus by raising him from the dead.
- (6) Hence, Jesus is vindicated as the unique Son of God.
