


Fig. 2.4 b) Schematic of DEEP QUEST as designed with potential divie lock out compartment and transfer bell. (LMSCI

In John 15, Christ identifies Himself as the [source] for bearing fruit in our lives. The metaphor is instructive if we let our minds turn to plant and soil relationships. Mutualistic fungi called mycorrhizae not only increase the absorptive area of plant root hairs a hundred-fold, but facilitate the exchange of water and nutrients, for plant sugars. They surround individual




Holy, Holy, Holy




Holy, Holy, Holy
