The term [harlot] applied to Babylon matches the practice of porneia attributed to her in 14:8. It is indicative of her spiritual harlotry and representative of an ecclesiastical or religious facet that is a counterfeit of the real. In prophetic language, prostitution, fornication, or adultery is equivalent to idolatry or religious apostasy.





Vlad III Dracula—better known by the gruesome moniker "Vlad the Impaler"—was a 15th-century

ruler of Wallachia (now part of Romania) who became notorious for his rampant use of torture, mutilation and mass murder. Vlad's military exploits saw him praised by many as a hero, but his unmatched cruelty and penchant for barbaric executions—often against his own people contributed to his reputation as one of history's most coldblooded leaders.

Vlad's victims were supposedly killed through unspeakable means including disembowelment, beheading and even being skinned or boiled alive. Still, his preferred method was impalement, a grisly process in which the victim had a wooden stake slowly driven through their body before being left to die of exposure...According to some accounts, Vlad enjoyed dining among the thousands of impaled bodies and would even dip his bread into the blood of his victims. This bizarre practice—along with the name "Dracula" and Vlad's birthplace of Transylvania—would later partly inspire the vampire in Bram Stoker's 1897 novel "Dracula."

"Called," elect," and "faithful" can apply only to saints, not to angels (Scott). Kletoi (called) and eklekltoi (elect) occur together in Matt. 22:14, where Jesus' statement is, "Many are called, but few are chosen." To be chosen by God is more than being called by Him. In order of time, kletoi comes first, but in order of moral significance eklektoi preceded kletoi (Swete). Not all who are called are chosen, but all who are chosen are called (cf. 2 Pet. 1:10) (Alford).

In Paul's writings, however, the call of God is always effectual. It amounts to an effectual call in this verse too, because "elect" applies to all the "called" in this triple designation. "Faithful" (Pistoi) indicates the fulfillment of the human response by this select group. The faithfulness of the saints climaxes the calling and election by God. It is their inevitable response to His initiative. Such a choice group will be fitting associates of the Lamb in His great victory.





The fornication of all the nations [porneias] and of the kings [eporneusan] is of the nature set forth in the final clause of the verse. The city has promoted herself by instilling an unquestioning faith in her supposedly inexhaustible resources, thereby discouraging any sense of a deeper need for God (Caird)...The connection of fornication and luxury in this verse indicates that Babylon's fornication consists not only of idolatry, but also includes her pride in excessive wealth (Johnson). False religion often has gone hand in hand with the accumulation and abusive use of luxury.


