- 1. What is one thing you are most *thankful* for this week?
- 2. What has been the most challenging part of your week? Pause and pray about what was shared.
- 3. Read Acts 4:5-22 two times and re-tell.

Application Questions

- 1. Peter shared the gospel in a moment of accusation (where it could have been easy to withhold or sidestep the Truth). Do you understand the story of Jesus well enough to share it with boldness and clarity?
- 2. Why is it "inverted" thinking to say that there is only one way to God? Why does the world hate this so much?
- 3. What happens around us when we don't speak of Jesus and God's work through Him? If light doesn't spread, what does? (John 8:12)
- 4. Jesus promises POWER to be His witnesses. So if we do not feel like we are walking with power in our lives...could it be that we are not witnessing to others?
- 5. The religious leaders clearly saw a move of Jesus but were threatened by it. Why? How can we do this in our own lives?
- 6. Do you feel that the MAIN goal of your life is to bring God glory? Why are we so hungry for God's glory for ourselves rather than for God?

Obey and Pray

- 1. What is the one thing that you feel God is **calling you to do** with what we have discussed in our time?
- 2. What do you need prayer for this week?
