- 1. What is one thing you are most *thankful* for this week?
- 2. What has been the most *challenging* part of your week? Pause and pray about what was shared.
- 3. Read Luke 10:25-37 two times and re-tell.

Application Questions

- 1. After hearing Hung's message on the Good Samaritan, is God opening your eyes to the hurting around you? What would it look like to take a step this week to learn more about the needs around you or in your community?
- 2. The Samaritan was moved by compassion for his "neighbor." What is the biblical definition of a neighbor? (Someone nearby and in need.) Was there a "neighbor" that God laid on your heart during the message? Are their limits to your compassion?
- 3. We learned from the Samaritan's example that loving your neighbor is messy. What would it look like for you to step into someone's mess? To be willing to bind up their wounds?
- 4. Loving your neighbor will cost you something. For the Samaritan, it required both his time and his money. Are you willing to lose momentary treasures for the sake of others?

Obey and Pray

- 1. What is the one thing that you feel God is **calling you to do** with what we have discussed in our time?
- 2. What do you need prayer for this week?
