## **Application Questions**

- 1. The first church was living in very divided times. Verse 44 tells us "Now all who believed were together, and had all things in common." What is capable within community when what you have in common is Jesus?
- 2. Brian talked about the extremes of the opinions of the world. Why is it important to remain focused on imitating the priorities of Jesus, rather than the current cultural opinion of the church?
- 3. If we were to look at your calendar and budget, what would it tell those around you that you value in this life? What would it look like to re-orient your current calendar and budget to more closely align with this first church?
- 4. Why has the church in America become so "programmed"? What are the dangers of placing your hope in programs over the priorities of Jesus?

  (Remember, the church can't follow Jesus for you)
- 5. Which of the four Steadfast steps Pastor Brian outlined (being in the word, community, prayer, and generosity) do you feel challenged to step into this week? What could keep you from taking a step this week?

- 2. What do you need prayer for this week?
