1. What is one thing you are most *thankful* for this week?

3. Read Acts 3:11 - 4:4 two times and re-tell.

Application Questions

1. When Peter had the opportunity to absorb the glory that was God's, he pointed the attention of the people back to God through Jesus Christ (v. 12-13). Why do we sometimes struggle to let the glory get to God, and take it for ourselves? What is the risk in doing this?
2. Peter had to distinguish that THIS healing happened because of the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. Why is it so vital to refer to the name/authority of JESUS CHRIST when we pray and when we speak of the one in which we follow? Does it really matter? (clue: verse 16)
3. Matt mentioned being confronted with the gospel. What does that mean? What is the gospel actually confronting us with?
4. What does it mean when Peter speaks under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit in verse 26 - "He sent Him first to you to *bless you by turning each of you from your wicked ways.*" How is it a blessing to turn from your wicked ways? Why is unrepentant sin so dangerous?
5. Would you say that you are expectant as it relates to God moving in your life today? What is trying to rob the "hope" of the power of God moving in your life today?

Obey and Pray

1. What is the one thing that you feel God is **calling you to do** with what we have discussed in our time?
2. What do you need prayer for this week?
