Application Questions

1. God tested Abraham more as a verification or proof of his faith in God. In what way is God testing or proving your faith right now? Is there anywhere you are delaying to obey?
 2. Abraham knew the promises of God, that gave him confidence when times seemed uncertain. What promises of God are you clinging to right now? Do you KNOW the promises and plans of God well enough to hold on to during the tough times? (i.e. Deut 31:8)
 3. Isaac learned absolute faith from his father Abraham. Who is someone (even if it was not your direct father), that you learned absolute faith from? What would it look like to reach out to them and tell them how grateful you are for them?
 4. Matt talked about how we struggle with the thought of a “perfect” Father. Why do we struggle with the concept of perfection as it relates to God?
 5. What are the characteristics of God that make him a Perfect Father? Which of the 3 (Provision, Protection, Presence) is the easiest to see God as? Which is the hardest?
