Application Questions

1. Pastor Zack said readiness is an act of preparation. Of the five points (worship, obey, unify, pray, devote), where do you feel the most ready? Least ready?
2. How often do you just pause to worship and remember what the Lord has done?
3. What does worship really look like for you? Is worship just singing songs? What else can worship be?
4. Do you feel confident that you know God's commands well enough to obey them? What needs to change in your life in order to prioritize being a student of God's word?
5. Why is it so challenging to walk in unity with one another? Is it just a 2024 issue? Or is there something deeper that divides us? (See *Genesis 3*)
6. On a scale of 1-10 (10 being always and 1 being never), how would you grade your prayer life currently? PERMISSION TO BE OPEN AND HONEST - what is your honest view of prayer?
7. God gave us His word through men in the 66 books of the Bible. Why is it important that we memorize His word? (*Psalms 119:9-11*) How did Pastor Zack say that the Holy Spirit most commonly speaks to us? What does He (The Holy Spirit) use most often?

Obey and Pray

1. What is the one thing that you feel God is calling you to do with what we have discussed in our time?
2. What do you need prayer for this week?
