- 2. talk of them when you

- B. when you walk by the way,
- C. when you lie down, and
- D. when you rise up.

 - as a sign on your hand, and
 - they shall be as frontlets between your eyes.
- 4. 9 You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

Our children will ask us why are we obeying the: testimonies, the statutes, and the judgments which the Lord our God has commanded you
