

# IN CHRIST

This teaching shows us who we are in Christ and what happened to us because of Calvary. It has examples of thanksgiving and praise after each scripture. Let's begin to go through them.

**Romans 3:24** Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.

Father, I thank You that I have been justified and redeemed freely by the grace of God.

**Romans 8:1** There is now therefore no condemnation to them that are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh but after the Spirit.

Father, I thank You that there is no condemnation unto me as I walk in Christ by the Spirit.

**Romans 8:2** For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Father, I thank You that Jesus has freed me from law and death and given me life through the Spirit of the living God.

**Romans 12:5** So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and everyone members one of another.

Father, I thank You that I am a member of one body, with my brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus.

**1 Cor. 1:2** Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours.

Father, I thank You that I am sanctified through the death and resurrection of the Lord. God has said that I am a Saint, holy, and blameless in Christ Jesus.

**1 Cor. 1:30** But of Him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption.

Father God, I thank You I am in Christ Jesus and therefore I am righteous, I am sanctified, set apart for God, through the redemption at the Cross.

**1 Cor. 15:22** For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

Father, I thank You for the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus, who cancelled out the law of sin and death. I am saved, sanctified, delivered, redeemed, justified, glorified, and eternal.

**2 Cor. 1:21** Now He which establisheth us with you in Christ, and hath anointed us, in God

Father, I thank You that I have the anointing of the Holy Spirit to do the works that Jesus did. Scripture says, these signs shall follow them that believe, I will cast out devils, speak in tongues, I am safe from Satan, as I proclaim the gospel, and lay hands on the sick, which recover.

**2 Cor. 3:14** But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same veil untaken away in the reading of the Old Testament; which veil is done away in Christ.

Thank You, Father, that the veil has been ripped open and I have free access each and every day to a holy and righteous God.

**2 Cor. 5:17** Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

I thank You, Father, that I am in a process of sanctification. The Holy Spirit is changing me and conforming me to the image and likeness of Christ.

**2 Cor. 5:19** To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto Himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.

Father, I thank You for the Word of reconciliation which keeps me free through the forgiveness and justification bought and paid for at Calvary. I greatly desire to share the gospel to the world.

**Gal. 2:4** And that because of false brethren unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage:

Father, I thank You that my liberty is safe, as I am protected by the Spirit of God from the bondage of heresies.

**Gal. 3:26** For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.

Thank You, Father, that I am a son of God, an heir of God, and a joint heir with Christ. Crucified with Christ, raised with Christ, and seated in heavenly places in Christ Jesus.

**Gal. 3:28** There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.

Father, I thank You that I am in Christ and Christ is in me. The same is true for all of my born-again brothers and sisters. There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism, One God, and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in us all.

**Gal. 5:6** For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth anything, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.

Father, I thank You for Your love, the love of Jesus and Your precious Holy Spirit. Because of this love: I have no fear, I have no torment, I am at peace, enjoying the glorious grace of God.

**Gal 6:15** For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth thing, nor uncircumcision, but a new creature.

Father, I thank You for grafting me into the olive tree. I thank You for making Jesus sin for me who knew no sin that I might be made the righteousness of God, a new creature in Christ Jesus. My circumcision is a circumcision of my heart by Your Spirit.

**Eph. 1:3** Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:

Thank You, Father, that I have been blessed with all of the blessing of the kingdom of God and have been raised with Christ Jesus to heavenly places.

**Eph. 1:10** That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; *even* in him: That in the dispensation of the fullness of times He might gather earth; even in Him:

Thank You, Father, that we are all one in Christ, here on earth, in heaven, in Him. Again, there is neither Jew or Greek, male, or female, bond or free but all of us are one body.

**Eph. 2:10** For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

Thank You, Father, that You have a divine plan for my life, a good plan, one that has been created by You for me. There is no need for me to fret concerning the future for it is already determined by You.

**Eph 2:13** But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ.

Father, I thank You for the blood of the Lamb that has caused me to be close to You. To bask in Your glory, to bathe in Your presence, to be filled with Your Spirit, and to walk in Your ways.

**Eph 3:6** That the Gentiles should be fellow heirs, and of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Christ by the gospel:

Father, I thank You that we are all one in Christ. There is no division, we are all recipients of the promise of the gospel of the kingdom. Thank You for the good news.

**Phil. 3:13-14** Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.

Father, I thank You for forgiveness and justification because my sin has been removed as far as the east is from the west. I am the head and not the tail, above and not beneath, following the leading of the Holy Spirit.

**Col. 1:28** Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus:

Father, I thank You that by understanding, Christ is in me, and He is my hope of glory, I can continue to move toward maturity.

**1 Thess. 4:16** For the Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

Father, I thank You for the rapture, the catching away of the true Church, where we will live with You forever. We that are alive will also be caught up to meet Jesus in the air and also, live with Him forever.

**1 Tim. 1:14** And the grace of our Lord was exceeding abundant with faith and love which is in Christ Jesus.

Thank You, Father, for the extraordinary love and grace that is in Christ Jesus through faith.

**2 Tim. 1:9** Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,

Father, I thank You for salvation, the desire You have given me for holiness and for Your kingdom. This is so very wonderful because there are no works involved in this kindness and generosity but totally given by Your grace

**2 Tim. 1:13** Hold fast the form of sound words, which thou hast heard of me, in faith and love which is in Christ Jesus.

Father, I thank You that Jesus is the Word, the Living Word, bringing faith and love to my life.

**2 Tim. 2:1** Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.

Thank You, Father, that You are strengthening me with all strength through grace by the power of the Holy Spirit.

**2 Tim. 2:10** Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.

Thank You, Father, for the example Paul left me. You caused him to have unfailing love for me, in his sufferings, which you deemed were necessary. I ask You to create in me the same type of selflessness and willingness to suffer for the body of Christ, if be necessary.

**2 Tim. 2:15** Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

Thank You, Father, for giving me a hunger for Your Word and for the kingdom principles in the gospel. Help me to always rightly divide the Word of Truth.

**Philemon 1:6** That the communication of thy faith may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus.

Father, I thank You for the faith and knowledge I have received from You and I desire to use them for every good work You have for me.

**2 Peter 1:8** For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Father, I thank You for the knowledge that the Holy Spirit continues to give me so I can contribute to kingdom business. Help me to do my part to focus on the Word of God, and in prayer, and to increase greatly in my quite time with You.

**2 John 1:9** Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son.

Thank You, Father, that 1 John 1:9 says, "if I will confess my sins, You are faithful and just to forgive me of my sins and cleanse me from all unrighteousness." I thank You for the gift of repentance and for the cleansing from sin and iniquity. I am thankful that I truly do not want to transgress the commandments of God.
