

## Submission – “Thy Will Be Done”

***Teach me to do Your will [so that I may please You], For You are my God;***

***Let Your good Spirit lead me on level ground.*** *Psalm 143.10 AMP.*

*Scripture References: Mt. 6:9b-10<sup>1</sup>; Eph. 2:10 AMP<sup>2</sup>; Ps 143:10 AMP<sup>3</sup>; Gal. 1:4 AMP<sup>4</sup>; Rm. 12:2<sup>5</sup>; 1 Thess. 4:3-5 AMP<sup>6</sup>; Eph. 1:4 AMP<sup>7</sup>; Ep 1:5<sup>8</sup>. Prayers That Avail Much.*

Father, I pray that the will of God be done in my life as it is in heaven<sup>1</sup>. For I am Your [own] handiwork (Your workmanship), recreated in Christ Jesus, [born anew] that I may do those good works which You predestined (planned beforehand) for me, (taking paths which You prepared ahead of time) that I should walk in them – [living the good life which You prearranged and made ready for me to live]<sup>2</sup>.

Teach me to do Your will, for You are my God; let Your Good Spirit lead me into a level country and into the land of uprightness<sup>3</sup>.

Jesus, You gave (yielded) Yourself up [to atone] for my sins [and to save and sanctify me], in order to rescue and deliver me from this present wicked age and world order, in accordance with the will and purpose and plan of our God and Father<sup>4</sup>.

In the name of Jesus, I am not conformed to this world: but am transformed by the renewing of my mind, that I may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God<sup>5</sup>.

For this is the will of God, that I should be consecrated – (separated and set apart for pure and holy living): that I should abstain and shrink from all sexual vice, that I should know how to possess [control, manage] my own body in consecration (purity, separated from things profane) and honor, not [to be used] in the passion of lust like the heathen, who are ignorant of the true God and have no knowledge of His will<sup>6</sup>.

Father, thank You that You chose me – [actually picked me out for Yourself and Your own] – in Christ before the foundation of the world, that I should be holy (consecrated and set apart for You) and blameless in Your sight, even above reproach, before You in love<sup>7</sup>;

having predestinated me unto the adoption of a child by Jesus Christ to Yourself, according to the good pleasure of Your will<sup>8</sup>.

Your will be done on earth in my life as it is in heaven. Amen and so be it!
