

# LENT PART 4: FROM BLINDNESS TO SIGHT

**Big Idea:** Jesus reveals and heals spiritual blindness, leading us to true sight.

**Theme:** Lent exposes blind spots in our hearts so Christ can transform us.

## I. The Lenten Journey

Lent is a time of self-examination and spiritual awareness.

- 1 Psalm 139:23–24 – Search my heart
- 2 2 Corinthians 13:5 – Examine yourselves

## II. Understanding Blind Spots

Blind spots are hidden areas of sin or pride we cannot easily see.

- 1 Jeremiah 17:9 – The heart is deceitful
- 2 1 Corinthians 10:12 – Be careful you don't fall

## III. Misunderstanding Suffering

Not all suffering is punishment—God can use it for purpose.

- 1 John 9:1–3
- 2 Romans 8:20–22

## IV. Obedience Leads to Breakthrough

The blind man obeyed Jesus and received sight.

- 1 John 9:6–7

## V. Spiritual Blindness of the Pharisees

Pride prevented the Pharisees from seeing the miracle.

- 1 Matthew 13:14–16
- 2 Romans 3:10

## VI. The Power of Testimony

The man simply said, 'I was blind, now I see.'

- 1 John 9:25
- 2 2 Corinthians 5:17

## **VII. Pride vs Humility**

Humility opens our eyes; pride blinds us.

- 1 Romans 1:21–22
- 2 James 4:6

## **VIII. Seeing and Believing**

True sight leads to faith and worship.

- 1 John 9:35–38

## **IX. The Great Reversal**

The blind will see, and the proud will become blind.

- 1 John 9:39

## **X. Living with Spiritual Sight**

We begin to see God working in everyday life.

- 1 Colossians 1:17
- 2 Hebrews 12:2
