

Bible Study Guide: Surrender Before Success

Primary Scripture:

Proverbs 16:3 – *“Commit to the Lord whatever you do, and He will establish your plans.”*

BIG IDEA

True success in God’s kingdom begins with surrender. When we release our plans and submit to God’s will, He establishes a path that leads to purpose, abundance, and lasting impact.

THEME

“Before success, there must be surrender.”

STUDY OVERVIEW

This study explores how our definition of success often conflicts with God’s design—and how surrendering our will transforms our lives, priorities, and outcomes.

SECTION 1: UNDERSTANDING GODLY SUCCESS

Key Insight

We often define success through personal achievement, control, and outcomes—but God defines success through obedience, surrender, and alignment with His will.

Supporting Scriptures

- **Joshua 1:8** – Success comes from obedience to God’s Word
- **Matthew 6:33** – Seek first the Kingdom, and everything else follows
- **Proverbs 3:5–6** – Trusting God leads to straight paths

Teaching Point

Success isn’t something we create—it’s something God establishes when we align with Him.

Discussion Questions

1. How do you currently define success in your life?
2. Where might your definition differ from God’s?
3. What would it look like to let God define success for you?

SECTION 2: YOUR SYSTEM VS. GOD’S SYSTEM

Key Insight

Your “system” is your way of thinking, planning, and living. If your system doesn’t change, you cannot fully experience God’s will.

Supporting Scriptures

- **Romans 12:2** – Be transformed by renewing your mind
- **Isaiah 55:8–9** – God’s ways are higher than ours
- **Colossians 3:2** – Set your mind on things above

Teaching Point

You cannot fit God into your existing system—you must adopt His system.

Practical Application

- Identify areas where your plans override God’s direction
- Begin aligning daily decisions with Scripture and prayer
- Replace control with trust

 2. Where is God asking you to change your thinking?
 3. What habits need to shift for God to take priority?

SECTION 3: THE POWER OF SURRENDER

Key Insight

Surrender is not weakness—it is the gateway to transformation and true success.

Supporting Scriptures

- **Luke 9:23** – Deny yourself and follow Jesus
- **Galatians 2:20** – Living a surrendered life in Christ
- **James 4:7–10** – Humble yourselves before the Lord

Teaching Point

Before God builds your future, He reshapes your heart.

Spiritual Truth

When you surrender your will, you:

- Gain new vision
- Receive a transformed heart
- Walk a new path designed by God

Discussion Questions

1. What areas of your life are hardest to surrender?
2. Why do we resist surrender?
3. What would full surrender look like for you this week?

SECTION 4: GOD ESTABLISHES YOUR PATH

Key Insight

When we commit our ways to the Lord, He doesn't just guide us—He establishes us.

Supporting Scriptures

- **Psalm 37:5** – Commit your way to the Lord
- **Jeremiah 29:11** – God's plans bring hope and a future
- **Psalm 20:4** – May He give you the desires of your heart

Teaching Point

God's establishment is stronger than our effort. His plans are secure, purposeful, and eternal.

Life Application

- Stop striving for control
- Start trusting God's process
- Let God define the outcome

Discussion Questions

1. Do you trust God to establish your plans?
2. Where are you still trying to control outcomes?

3. How can you practice daily commitment to God?

SECTION 5: LIVING A SURRENDERED LIFE

Key Insight

A surrendered life produces:

- Abundant life
- A legacy of faith
- A life that honors God

Supporting Scriptures

- **John 10:10** – Jesus brings abundant life
- **Matthew 5:16** – Live to glorify God
- **2 Timothy 4:7–8** – Finishing life faithfully

Teaching Point

Surrender isn't a one-time decision—it's a daily lifestyle.

Practical Steps

1. Start each day in surrender through prayer
2. Evaluate decisions through God's will
3. Stay flexible to God's leading
4. Trust God even when outcomes are unclear

Discussion Questions

1. What daily habits help you stay surrendered?
 2. How can you keep God at the center of your plans?
 3. What kind of legacy are you building?
