

# **Bible Study Guide: At the Well – From Isolation to Impact**

 Source Transcript:

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## **Big Idea**

**Jesus meets us in our ordinary routines, breaks through our barriers, and transforms our lives—calling us out of isolation into relationship and from shame into purpose.**

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## **Theme**

**The encounter at the well reveals that true life is found not in what we seek from the world, but in a personal relationship with Christ that transforms us and sends us to others.**

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## **Core Scriptures**

**John 4:4–26**

Jesus and the Samaritan woman

**John 4:28–30**

The woman shares her testimony

## **Romans 10:15**

“How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news.”

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### **Introduction: The Power of an Ordinary Moment**

The woman’s story begins:

- In routine
- In isolation
- In shame

Yet it becomes:

- A moment of transformation
- A moment of purpose
- A moment of impact

### **Key Insight:**

“Jesus meets you in your everyday routine and asks—  
what are you really seeking?”

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### **Main Point 1: Jesus Meets Us in Our Routine**

#### **Explanation**

The woman:

- Comes to draw water
- Is doing something ordinary

Jesus:

- Interrupts the ordinary
- Creates a divine moment

“Stop being a zombie—notice that Jesus is walking with you.”

## **Spiritual Truth**

God often speaks:

- In everyday life
- In routine moments

## **Application**

- Where is Jesus trying to meet me daily?
- Am I aware of His presence?

## **Sticky Quote:**

“God shows up in your ordinary moments.”

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## **Main Point 2: Barriers Do Not Stop Jesus**

### **Explanation**

Barriers in the story:

- Jew vs. Samaritan
- Man vs. woman
- Righteous vs. sinner

Yet Jesus:

- Crosses every line

“Jesus was never afraid to cross barriers.”

## **Spiritual Truth**

Nothing:

- Your past
- Your sin
- Your identity

Can stop Jesus from reaching you

## **Application**

- What barriers do I think separate me from God?
- What barriers keep me from others?

## **Sticky Quote:**

“Jesus crosses every line to reach you.”

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**Main Point 3: We Misidentify Our True Thirst**

## **Explanation**

The woman:

- Thinks she needs water

Jesus reveals:

- She needs something deeper

“What are you really thirsty for?”

## **Spiritual Truth**

We often seek:

- Temporary satisfaction

Instead of:

- Eternal fulfillment

## **Application**

- What am I chasing right now?
- Is it truly satisfying?

## **Sticky Quote:**

“What you think you need may not be what your soul needs.”

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**Main Point 4: Isolation Is Not the Answer**

## **Explanation**

The woman:

- Comes alone
- Avoids others

“She thought isolation would protect her.”

## **Spiritual Truth**

Isolation:

- Protects temporarily
- Damages long-term

Jesus offers:

- Relationship
- Healing
- Connection

## **Application**

- Where am I isolating myself?
- How can I step into community?

## **Sticky Quote:**

“Isolation hides pain—relationship heals it.”

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**Main Point 5: Jesus Knows Your Story Fully**

## **Explanation**

Jesus:

- Reveals her past
- Knows her struggles

Yet:

- Does not reject her

“He knew everything about her—and still engaged her.”

## **Spiritual Truth**

God’s knowledge:

- Does not condemn
- Invites transformation

## **Application**

- Am I afraid to be fully known?
- Do I trust God with my story?

## **Sticky Quote:**

“Being fully known does not mean being rejected.”

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## **Main Point 6: Relationship Replaces Religion**

### **Explanation**

The woman:

- Talks about where to worship

Jesus redirects:

- Worship is about spirit and truth

“It’s not isolation anymore—it’s relationship.”

## **Spiritual Truth**

Faith is:

- Not ritual
- Not location

It is:

- Relationship

## **Application**

- Is my faith relational or routine?
- Do I know Jesus personally?

## **Sticky Quote:**

“God desires relationship—not just religion.”

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## **Main Point 7: One Encounter Changes Everything**

### **Explanation**

The woman:

- Moves from confusion
- To clarity
- To transformation

“Her life changed in one encounter.”

## **Spiritual Truth**

Jesus can:

- Instantly transform
- Completely renew

## **Application**

- Have I experienced real transformation?
- What is God changing in me?

## **Sticky Quote:**

“One moment with Jesus can change your life forever.”

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## **Main Point 8: Transformation Leads to Bold Witness**

### **Explanation**

She:

- Leaves her water jar
- Runs back to the village

“Be the reason someone runs.”

## **Spiritual Truth**

When transformed:

- You cannot stay silent

## **Application**

- Am I sharing my story?
- What holds me back?

## **Sticky Quote:**

“Transformation produces testimony.”

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## **Main Point 9: Your Past Does Not Disqualify You**

### **Explanation**

The woman:

- Had a broken past
- Was rejected

Yet:

- Becomes a messenger

“God uses broken people.”

## **Spiritual Truth**

Your past:

- Becomes your testimony

### **Application**

- Do I feel disqualified?
- How can God use my story?

### **Sticky Quote:**

“Your past is not your limitation—it’s your platform.”

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## **Main Point 10: You Are Either Receiving or Giving Life**

### **Explanation**

At the well:

- Some are thirsty
- Some are ready to give

“You’re either coming to receive—or to share.”

### **Spiritual Truth**

We are called to:

- Be filled
- Then pour out

## **Application**

- Where am I in my journey?
- Who can I pour into?

## **Sticky Quote:**

“Receive from Jesus—then give to others.”

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## **Discussion Questions**

1. What are you truly seeking in life right now?
  2. Where are you isolating instead of connecting?
  3. What barriers do you believe separate you from God?
  4. How has Jesus transformed your life?
  5. Who can you share your story with this week?
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## **Practical Application Steps**

### **1. Slow Down and Notice God**

- Be aware of His presence daily

### **2. Identify False “Wells”**

- Replace temporary fixes with Christ

### **3. Step Out of Isolation**

- Engage in community

## **4. Embrace Your Story**

- Let God use your past

## **5. Share Your Faith Boldly**

- Be a witness to others

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## **Closing Prayer**

and draw us into relationship with You.

Transform our hearts  
and give us the courage  
to share Your love with others.
