

Bible Study Guide: Tilling the Heart – From Routine Faith to Real Transformation

 Source Transcript:

Big Idea

Lent is a season of breaking up the hardened areas of our hearts, turning away from worldly dependence, and allowing God to reshape us through repentance, surrender, and intentional relationship.

Theme

True spiritual growth happens when we stop relying on our own strength and return to God with humility, allowing Him to transform our hearts and redefine how we live.

Core Scriptures

Joel 2:12–13

“Return to me with all your heart...”

Philippians 4:13

“I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.”

Introduction: The Tilling Season

Lent is like:

- A farmer preparing the soil
- Breaking up hard ground
- Making room for growth

Key Insight:

“Lent is the season where God breaks up what is hard so He can grow something new.”

Main Point 1: Lent Is a Call to Return

Explanation

We often:

- Drift into worldly patterns

Lent calls us to:

- Return to God

Spiritual Truth

Returning requires:

- Awareness
- Intention

“Lent is about returning to God in spirit.”

Application

- Where have I drifted?
- What needs to change?

Sticky Quote:

“Return is the first step to renewal.”

Main Point 2: We Replace God with Worldly “Fixes”

Explanation

We substitute God with:

- Habits
- Comforts
- Addictions

Spiritual Truth

These “fixes”:

- Replace dependence on God

“What have you replaced God with?”

Application

- What do I run to instead of God?
- Why?

Sticky Quote:

“Whatever replaces God becomes your god.”

Main Point 3: True Change Begins with Repentance

Explanation

Repentance means:

- Turning away
- Admitting need

Spiritual Truth

Without repentance:

- There is no transformation

“A repentant heart is the beginning.”

Application

- What do I need to repent of?
- Am I willing?

Sticky Quote:

“Repentance prepares the heart.”

Main Point 4: We Cannot Live in Our Own Strength**Explanation**

Trying to control life leads to:

- Stress
- Exhaustion
- Frustration

Spiritual Truth

True strength comes from:

- Christ

“You cannot do life on your own.”

Application

- Where am I relying on myself?
- How can I depend on God?

Sticky Quote:

“Self-reliance leads to exhaustion—God reliance leads to peace.”

Main Point 5: Humility Opens the Door to Change

Explanation

Humility says:

- “I need God”

Spiritual Truth

Pride blocks:

- Growth
- Relationship

“If you don’t think you have sin, that is the problem.”

Application

- Where am I prideful?
- What needs surrender?

Sticky Quote:

“Humility invites transformation.”

Main Point 6: The Heart Must Be Reworked

Explanation

Like soil:

- The heart must be broken up

Spiritual Truth

God reshapes:

- Desires
- Motives
- Priorities

“This is your tilling season.”

Application

- What areas of my heart are hardened?
- What needs softening?

Sticky Quote:

“God tills the heart before He grows it.”

Main Point 7: Your View of God Shapes Your Faith

Explanation

Many people believe:

- False narratives about God

Spiritual Truth

Your relationship with God depends on:

- How you see Him

“You must know who God really is.”

Application

- What do I believe about God?
- Is it true?

Sticky Quote:

“Your view of God shapes your walk with Him.”

Main Point 8: Jesus Reveals the True Nature of God

Explanation

Jesus shows:

- God’s love
- God’s mercy
- God’s accessibility

Spiritual Truth

To know God:

- Look at Jesus

“If you’ve seen Jesus, you’ve seen the Father.”

Application

- Am I studying Jesus’ life?

- What is He showing me?

Sticky Quote:

“Jesus is the true picture of God.”

Main Point 9: Community Strengthens Transformation

Explanation

Faith is not meant to be:

- Lived alone

Spiritual Truth

Growth happens in:

- Community
- Accountability

“Walk this journey together.”

Application

- Who am I walking with?
- Am I connected?

Sticky Quote:

“Faith grows in community.”

Main Point 10: Spiritual Disciplines Recenter Your Life

Explanation

Practices include:

- Prayer
- Scripture
- Worship
- Rest

Spiritual Truth

These:

- Replace worldly dependence

“Make space for God.”

Application

- What disciplines do I need?
- How can I be consistent?

Sticky Quote:

“Make space for God to work.”

Main Point 11: Rest Is an Act of Surrender

Explanation

Sleep and stillness:

- Reflect trust in God

Spiritual Truth

Rest:

- Renews body and spirit

“Sleep is surrender.”

Application

- Am I resting in God?
- Or striving constantly?

Sticky Quote:

“Rest reflects trust.”

Main Point 12: Worship Changes the Atmosphere

Explanation

Worship:

- Shifts perspective
- Brings God’s presence

Spiritual Truth

Worship:

- Is daily
- Is personal

“Worship changes everything.”

Application

- What am I listening to?
- What am I focusing on?

Sticky Quote:

“Worship invites God’s presence.”

1. What “fixes” have replaced God in your life?
 2. What false beliefs about God might you be carrying?
 3. Where do you need to repent and surrender?
 4. How is your heart being shaped right now?
 5. What spiritual practices can you start today?
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Practical Application Steps

1. Reflect Honestly

- Examine your heart

2. Repent Fully

- Turn away from sin

3. Replace Worldly Habits

- Introduce spiritual disciplines

4. Rest in God

- Practice surrender

5. Walk in Community

- Share the journey
