

Bible Study Guide: Led into the Wilderness – Choosing God’s Will Above All

 Source Transcript:

Big Idea

True transformation begins when we fully surrender our will to God, allowing Him to lead us—even through the wilderness—so He can shape our hearts and prepare us for His purpose.

Theme

Lent is a season of surrender where we choose God’s will over our own, resist temptation, and allow Him to transform us through testing and dependence.

Core Scripture

Matthew 4:1–2

“Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. After fasting forty days and forty nights, He was hungry.”

Introduction: A Defining Moment

At the beginning of His ministry:

- Jesus is led into the wilderness
- He faces testing and hunger
- He declares full dependence on God

Key Insight:

“The wilderness reveals whether we will follow our will or God’s will.”

Main Point 1: God Leads the Journey

Explanation

Jesus was:

- Led by the Spirit

Spiritual Truth

Even difficult seasons:

- Are under God’s direction

“This journey is shaped by God.”

Application

- Do I trust God’s leading?
- Where is He guiding me?

Sticky Quote:

“God leads—even into hard places.”

Main Point 2: The Wilderness Is a Place of Testing

Explanation

Jesus:

- Faces temptation

Spiritual Truth

Testing:

- Reveals faith
- Strengthens character

“Temptation is part of the process.”

Application

- What tests am I facing?
- How am I responding?

Sticky Quote:

“Testing reveals your foundation.”

Main Point 3: Hunger Reveals Dependence

Explanation

After fasting:

- Jesus is physically weak

Spiritual Truth

Weakness:

- Drives us toward God

“Hunger reminds us of our need.”

Application

- What areas expose my need for God?
- Am I turning to Him?

Sticky Quote:

“Your need leads you to God.”

Main Point 4: The Battle Is Between Two Wills

Explanation

Jesus chooses:

- God's will over His own

Spiritual Truth

Every day we choose:

- Our will or God's

“Will you be shaped by you or by God?”

Application

- Whose will am I following?
- What needs surrender?

Sticky Quote:

“Two wills—one choice.”

Main Point 5: Full Surrender Changes Everything

Explanation

Jesus:

- Fully submits to God

Spiritual Truth

Surrender:

- Unlocks transformation

“Full surrender leads to change.”

Application

- What am I holding back?
- Can I fully surrender?

Sticky Quote:

“Surrender opens the door to transformation.”

Main Point 6: Lent Is a Journey of Surrender

Explanation

Lent mirrors:

- Jesus’ wilderness

Spiritual Truth

This season calls for:

- Reflection
- Change
- Commitment

“Let Lent be shaped by God.”

Application

- How am I approaching Lent?

- Am I letting God lead?

Sticky Quote:

“Lent reshapes your heart.”

Main Point 7: Obedience Is the Path Forward

Explanation

Jesus:

- Chooses obedience

Spiritual Truth

Obedience:

- Aligns us with God

“Be obedient to God.”

Application

- Where is God calling me to obey?
- Am I resisting?

Sticky Quote:

“Obedience aligns your life.”

Main Point 8: Temptation Tries to Pull You Away

Explanation

The enemy:

- Offers shortcuts
- Challenges trust

Spiritual Truth

Temptation:

- Distracts from God's will

“Don't be led by the world.”

Application

- What pulls me away from God?
- How can I resist?

Sticky Quote:

“Temptation pulls—truth anchors.”

Main Point 9: God First Must Be the Foundation

Explanation

Jesus models:

- God-first living

Spiritual Truth

Priority determines:

- Direction
- Outcome

“God comes first—always.”

Application

- Is God truly first in my life?
- What needs to change?

Sticky Quote:

“Put God first—everything follows.”

Main Point 10: The Wilderness Leads to Transformation

Explanation

The wilderness:

- Prepares Jesus for ministry

Spiritual Truth

God uses:

- Hard seasons to shape us

“God will change your heart.”

Application

- What is God doing in me?
- Am I open to change?

Sticky Quote:

“The wilderness transforms you.”
