II. Storms Reveal What You Trust

Storms expose whether we trust God, ourselves, or others.

- 2 Proverbs 3:5

III. Storms Remove Control

Storms remind us that we are not in control and must rely on God.

- 1 Psalm 46:10
- 2 James 4:14

IV. Jesus is Not Afraid

What terrifies us does not intimidate Jesus.

- 1 Mark 4:39
- 2 2 Timothy 1:7

V. The Power of Jesus' Voice

Jesus speaks peace into chaos and truth into our hearts.

- 1 John 10:27
- 2 Luke 23:34

VI. Storms Build Maturity

God uses trials to grow our faith and endurance.

- 1 James 1:2–4
- 2 Romans 5:3–5

VII. Who is Jesus to You?

The storm reveals our understanding of who Jesus is.

- 1 Mark 4:41
- 2 Matthew 16:15

VIII. Jesus is the Foundation

Jesus is not an add-on; He is the cornerstone of life.

- 1 Ephesians 2:20
- 2 Colossians 3:17

IX. Peace in the Storm

Jesus brings peace even when the storm continues.

- 1 John 14:27
