

Bible Study Guide: Into the Wilderness – Surrendering to God’s Will

 Source Transcript:

Big Idea

The wilderness is not a place of defeat but a place of transformation—where surrender to God’s will strengthens us and prepares us for what He has ahead.

Theme

Lent invites us into a spiritual wilderness where we learn to put God first, resist temptation, and fully surrender our lives to His will.

Core Scripture

Matthew 4:1–2

“Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. After fasting forty days and forty nights, He was hungry.”

Introduction: The Wilderness Is Part of the Journey

Before Jesus begins His ministry:

- He enters the wilderness
- He faces testing
- He experiences hunger

Key Insight:

“The wilderness is where surrender is tested and faith is strengthened.”

The Purpose of the Wilderness

- Not punishment
 - Preparation

Main Point 1: God Leads Us into the Wilderness

Explanation

Jesus was:

- Led by the Spirit

Spiritual Truth

Difficult seasons:

- Are not random
- Are part of God's plan

“God is leading you—even here.”

Application

- What wilderness am I in?
- Can I trust God in it?

Sticky Quote:

“God leads even into the wilderness.”

Main Point 2: The Wilderness Reveals What Is Inside You

Explanation

In isolation:

- Distractions fade
- Truth surfaces

Spiritual Truth

The wilderness exposes:

- Weakness
- Dependence

“The wilderness reveals your heart.”

Application

- What is being revealed in me?
- What needs to change?

Sticky Quote:

“What is revealed can be healed.”

Main Point 3: Temptation Is Part of the Journey

Explanation

Jesus was:

- Tempted

Spiritual Truth

Temptation:

- Is inevitable
- Tests your focus

“You will face temptation.”

Application

- What temptations do I face?
- How do I respond?

Sticky Quote:

“Temptation tests your direction.”

Main Point 4: Hunger Teaches Dependence

Explanation

Jesus fasted:

- 40 days
- Experienced hunger

Spiritual Truth

Physical hunger points to:

- Spiritual need

“Hunger reveals dependence.”

Application

- What do I depend on?
- Am I relying on God?

Sticky Quote:

“Hunger drives dependence on God.”

Main Point 5: Surrender Means Choosing God’s Will

Explanation

Jesus chooses:

- God's will over His own

Spiritual Truth

True surrender:

- Aligns with God

“Not my will, but God's.”

Application

- Whose will am I following?
- What needs to change?

Sticky Quote:

“Surrender aligns your life.”

Main Point 6: Lent Is a Time of Testing and Growth

Explanation

Lent mirrors:

- Jesus' wilderness

Spiritual Truth

It is a time to:

- Grow
- Refocus

“Lent is your wilderness journey.”

Application

- How am I engaging this season?
- What is God teaching me?

Sticky Quote:

“Lent strengthens your faith.”

Main Point 7: Obedience Overcomes Temptation

Explanation

Jesus:

- Chooses obedience

Spiritual Truth

Victory comes through:

- Faithfulness

“Obedience leads to victory.”

Application

- Where is God calling me to obey?
- Am I listening?

Sticky Quote:

“Obedience defeats temptation.”

Main Point 8: Full Surrender Brings Transformation

Explanation

When we surrender:

- God changes us

Spiritual Truth

Transformation requires:

- Letting go

“Allow God to change your heart.”

Application

- What am I holding onto?
- Can I release it?

Sticky Quote:

“Surrender opens the door to change.”

Main Point 9: God Must Come First

Explanation

Jesus models:

- God-first living

Spiritual Truth

Priority determines:

- Direction

“God comes first always.”

Application

- Is God first in my life?
- What needs reordering?

Sticky Quote:

“Priority reveals devotion.”

Main Point 10: The Wilderness Prepares You for Purpose

Explanation

After the wilderness:

- Jesus begins ministry

Spiritual Truth

Preparation leads to:

- Purpose

“The wilderness prepares you.”

Application

- What is God preparing me for?
- Am I trusting the process?

Sticky Quote:

“Preparation precedes purpose.”
