Last Week – Jesus Is The Truth

- Knowing Jesus IS knowing the truth. We follow Christ not just principles.
- John 1:14 - ... full of grace and truth..
- John 14:6 - ...I am...the truth..
- Revelation 19:11 – ...called Faithful and True...

- **11** Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the **wiles** of the devil.
- **14** Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth,
and having put on the breastplate of righteousness,

This Week – The Spirit Of Truth

- John 16:13 - the Spirit of truth...will guide you into all truth
- 1 Cor 2:9-14 - the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God
- 1 John 2:27 - the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth

1. The Holy Spirit Reveals And Confirms The Truth

- John 16:13
- 13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

1. The Holy Spirit Reveals And Confirms The Truth

- **A.** The Holy Spirit is NOT a force – he is a person
- **B.** The Holy Spirit knows all truth, and guides believers into all truth
- **C.** The Holy Spirit reveals Jesus and what is to come (..for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy Rev 19:10)

2. Truth Must Be Spiritually Discerned

- 1 Cor 2:9-14
- 9 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.
- 10 But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

2. Truth Must Be Spiritually Discerned

- 1 Cor 2:9-14
- 11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.
- 12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.

2. Truth Must Be Spiritually Discerned

- 1 Cor 2:9-14
- 13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.
- 14 But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

2. Truth Must Be Spiritually Discerned

- **A.** If you want revelation from God – you need His Spirit
- **B.** The things of God are better than the things of this world
- **C.** If you consider the things of God to be foolishness – this is evidence for your lack of Spiritual discernment

2. Truth Must Be Spiritually Discerned

- 2 Kings 6:16-17
- 16 And he answered, Fear not: for they that be with us are more than they that be with them.
- 17 And Elisha prayed, and said, Lord, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the Lord opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.

2. Truth Must Be Spiritually Discerned

- Ephesians 3:20-21
- 20 Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us,
- 21 to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.

3. You Know All Truth

- 1 John 2:25-27
- 25 And this is the promise that he hath promised us, even eternal life.
- 26 These things have I written unto you concerning them that seduce you.

3. You Know All Truth

- 1 John 2:25-27
- 27 But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.

3. You Know All Truth

- **A.** Do not let the enemy bully you
- **B.** There is nothing more sad than a person who has lost everything, with no chance of ever getting it back who tries to convince you that what you have is worthless

3. You Know All Truth

◦What a friend we have in Jesus,
All our sins and griefs to bear!
What a privilege to carry
Everything to God in prayer!
Oh, what peace we often forfeit,
Oh, what needless pain we bear,
All because we do not carry
Everything to God in prayer!

3. You Know All Truth

◦Have we trials and temptations?
Is there trouble anywhere?
We should never be discouraged—
Take it to the Lord in prayer.
Can we find a friend so faithful,
Who will all our sorrows share?
Jesus knows our every weakness;
Take it to the Lord in prayer.

3. You Know All Truth

◦Are we weak and heavy-laden,
Cumbered with a load of care?
Precious Savior, still our refuge—
Take it to the Lord in prayer.
Do thy friends despise, forsake thee?
Take it to the Lord in prayer!
In His arms He'll take and shield thee,
Thou wilt find a solace there.

3. You Know All Truth

◦Blessed Savior, Thou hast promised
Thou wilt all our burdens bear;
May we ever, Lord, be bringing
All to Thee in earnest prayer.
Soon in glory bright, unclouded,
There will be no need for prayer—
Rapture, praise, and endless worship
Will be our sweet portion there.
